Authorization of foreign pilots for flights in Switzerland

If the domicile is outside Switzerland occasional flights in Switzerland as a pilot with the international pilot identification card (IPPI) level IV or V are allowed. This identification card is to obtain from your own country's organization.
Tandem flights and the activity as a flight instructor are not permitted.
For flights in Switzerland a liability insurance of at least 1 million CHF is prescribed.
The marking of the aircraft is void.

Domicile in Switzerland

If the pilots domicile is in Switzerland the Swiss licence in the appropriate category is obligatory.

How to get the Swiss licences

Overview of Swiss licences with the most important conditions (not complete):

Pilot	unlimited flights	50 flights	theory practice	125.- 125.-
Tandem B:	tandem flights with other pilot	1 year of pilot license instruction flight	practice	125.-
Tandem A:	flights with passenger (commercial and not commercial)	½ year tandem B 40 flights	theory practice solo practice tandem	125.- 550.- 200.-
Instructor:	activity as a flight instructor		theory practice educational	550.- 550.- 650.-
